2) Update on Ellis Place

- CMHA Kelowna
 - i) Residents had a positive holiday and received donated gifts and decorations.
 - ii) The structure that will hold the dumpsters is being built starting tomorrow. This should help to contain garbage that is being spread around the back alleyway and prevent anyone from entering the dumpsters.
 - iii) Community associations and members are contacting CMHA Kelowna to ask questions and relationships are being built with these individuals.
 - iv) Initiatives to foster community building within Ellis Place are ongoing despite limitations due to COVID-19. Communal art projects are helping to develop a sense of community.

3) Ellis Place – Roundtable Discussion

Challenges or concerns

Community Representative: Employees at the Monashee building next door are concerned about landscaping rocks that are being moved over to their property from Ellis Place. Employees are concerned the rocks are being thrown and may cause damage. They are also moving the rocks back each morning.

Community Policing: Explained the process for reporting damage caused by vandalism.

Community Representative: M & T motors have noticed the issues related to garbage that are being actively addressed. No other complaints or concerns.
