- CMHA Kelowna
 - i) Adult floor is full. The youth floor has 4 open beds. There were 3 move-ins this week, and two youth are moving out to more independent living situations.
 - ii) One participant found employment at UBCO, which is a significant move forward in their recovery journey.
 - iii) Residents built a gazebo for the backyard and continue to take pride and ownership in their home.
 - iv) Recent activities/ events include: Thanksgiving dinner, a new curling team, and participant led art classes.
 - v) One staff member at McCurdy Place has access to a bus and they have been able to use that to take residents on outings such as hiking.

 - i) Community Representative: Have noticed increased traffic of individuals with shopping carts etc. in the area. Possibly transporting stolen goods. Response: Some have noticed an increase in homelessness throughout Kelowna. Recommendation to contact RCMP if there is suspected illegal activity.
